Content	Three bylaws envision Bogota's green infrastructure future: the policy on eco-urbanism and sustainable construction from 2014 to 2024 (Bylaw 566), the green building recognition program (Bylaw 3654) and the roof greening guidelines (Bylaw 418). As the city's major urban planning regulations (POT) are currently under revision, these 3 bylaws set the roadmap for a number of local programs designed to adapt the city to climate change and augment people's and local ecosystems' health. Particular focus is given to environmental services related to air quality, water cycle and heat island effect. This approach that aims to enhance overall Bogota region's environmental quality brings conservation, restoration, building efficiency and building eco-productivity together under the same green canopy.
